CRUISER WARRANTY

MARINER CRUISERS (MFG.) PTY. LIMITED ("THE MANUFACTURER") MAKES THE FOLLOWING WARRANTY TO THE ORIGINAL RETAIL PURCHASER:

- 1. The Manufacturer warrants each new boat manufactured by it to be free from defects in materials and workmanship under normal use and service for a period which shall expire twelve months after the date of delivery to the first retail purchaser thereof, except in the case of commercial use. In the case of commercial use the warranty shall be for a period of 3 months from the date of delivery.
- 2. During the warranty period specified above the Company will through its selling Dealer replace or repair, at the Company's option, any part (except as hereinafter provided) which is proven to its satisfaction to be defective under normal use and service within 12 months from the date of delivery to the first owner if the part is returned, transportation prepaid, within thirty days after the defect is discovered, to the Dealer or to such other point of manufacture as the Company may designate.
- 3. This warranty shall not apply to:
 - (a) The cost of removal or reinstallment of part, or disassembly or reassembly of the unit of which it is a component.
 - (b) Varnishes, gelcoats, paints, fabrics, chromium plated and stainless steel finishes because of the varying effect resulting from different climatic and use conditions.
 - (c) Products not of the Company's manufacture. Any warranty provided by the manufacturer will be passed on to the owner if possible.
 - (d) The installation of any equipment by a Dealer or other installer.
 - (e) Racing boats or engines.
 - (f) Speeds, fuel consumption and other performance characteristics because they are estimated and not guaranteed.
 - (g) Parts which have been altered in a manner which has impaired the original characteristics.
 - (h) Others than the first owner.
 - (i) Boats that are used in military activities.
- 4. THE COMPANY OR ITS DEALER SHALL NOT BE LIABLE UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES FOR INCIDENTAL, CONSEQUENTIAL OR INDIRECT DAMAGES CAUSED BY DEFECTS IN MATERIALS OR WORKMANSHIP OR ANY DELAY IN THE REPAIR OR REPLACEMENT THEREOF.
- 5. THE DEALER IS NOT THE AGENT OF THE MANUFACTURER. The Company does not authorise the Dealer, or any other person, to assume for the

- Company any liability in connection herewith or any liability or expense incurred in the repairing of its products other than those expressly authorised herein.
- 6. The Company reserves the right to improve its products through changes in design or material without being obligated to incorporate such changes in products of prior manufacture.
- 7. You may secure performance of warranty obligations hereunder by:
 - (a) Telephoning the Mariner dealer from which you purchased the boat for an appointment to have the dealer examine your Mariner boat.
 - (b) Delivering your Mariner boat to the selling Mariner dealer for his examination.
 - (c) The dealer must receive authorisation from the Mariner Service Department to carry out warranty repairs.
 - (d) Upon completion of warranty obligations the dealer will notify you of the availability of your Mariner boat for your pickup.
 - (e) Major mechanical components, such as engines, generator sets, electronics, appliances and air conditioning, for example, are warranted by the manufacturer of the component. They have authorised service dealers in most major boating markets, your mainter dealer will identify service dealers upon request.
