The Eastport 32 features a single level deck, lots of shade, galley-up with a huge cockpit, inboard common rail turbo charged volvo diesel engines, a 22 inch go-anywhere draft and the "Tailgate". Delivered all over the world.

The Eastport 32 is a series built thirty-two foot long yacht, inheriting its classical lines from the Chesapeake Bay Deadrise, the waterman's working vessel. Each boat is constructed with pride and care using modern composite materials, innovative design and attention to detail. All with an attractive factory direct pricing and builder warranties for outstanding value in today's market. Cruising comfortably at 25 knots and top speed of 32 knots with standard fuel efficient twin Volvo 260HP common rail turbo charged diesel engines, burning only 14 Gallons per hour at top speed. The Eastport 32 has a range of over 400 miles on a single tank and a "go anywhere" shallow draft of only 22 inches with maximum manoeuvrability for ease of docking. Designed with a deep V on entry and soft flare in the bow, a moderate aft deadrise angle of 12 degrees, with hard chines and lifting strakes for a dry, comfortable ride. Features include the innovative dropdown tailgate/swim platform for easy access to the water, an enclosed head and a double "V" berth in the forward cabin, ample seating in the large open cockpit which converts into a "bunk" and an on deck Wet bar/Galley for entertaining. The luxurious "Pilot House" helm seat is the center of the ergonomically designed steering console with great all-round visibility and an outdoor feel, with an extended hard top for protection from the elements. 



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FAQ about the Eastport 32.

We do get a lot of questions about our boats - here are a sample with the best answers we can give:

Q: How long have you been building the Eastport 32? A: We started design and tooling in 2006 and launched the first boat in 2007.

Q: How many have you built? A: We are completing #16 with #17 in the pipeline

Q; Where are the boats? A: About 30% are in the Chesapeake Bay, the rest are spread between Florida, The Carolina's, The Bahamas, Australia, Bermuda and Italy.

Q: Can I get one with a single engine? A: Not really, we have tooled up for twin engine layout. To configure the molds for single engine would be a costly exercise.

Q: What is the draft? A: The deepest part of the boat is forward at 22" the props are 19" deep.

Q: Can I get outboards? A: Yes – optional 2 x 250HP Yamaha Outboards on a an custom aft bracket

Q How capable is the Eastport 32 Offshore? A: Its a great offshore boat, we have taken Eastport 32's from New England to Key West, offshore. Eastport 32's regularly make the trip from the Chesapeake to New England in the summer and Eastport 32's cross the Gulf stream from Florida to the Bahama's every season.

Q: What is the hull shape? A: The hull underbody is based on the modern Carolina Sportfishing boat - Modified V - with twin prop pockets. Very efficient in a sea way and stable at slow speed for trolling or creek cruising. Call to discuss more about this.







- Q: What is the fuel economy? A: An incredible 2.27 miles/Gal at 25kts with a 440 mile range (with standard power)
- Q: Do you offer specific options? A: Yes we build each boat to suit, in collaboration with each of our clients we build the boat that suits your needs and wishes best.
- Q: Do you have used boats? A: Yes, sometimes. Typically they don't stay on the market long,
- Q: Can I fish on the Eastport 32? A: The boat is an outstanding fishing platform Either for offshore blue water Pelagic's like Blue and White Marlin, closer to home reef fishing and particularly the Chesapeake Bay style fishing of trolling, light tackle or live lining.
- Q: How does the boat ride? A: It is designed to handle steep bay style chop with deep V forward, we have moderate lifting strakes that are not too wide for a soft ride. Turns like a sports car. Down sea runs straight and true. Proven annual migration, as Tom takes his Eastport 32 annually up and down the USA East coast from Annapolis to Florida keys with many fun stops exploring in-between. The Eastport 32 is at home riding the Gulf stream and all it has to offer.
- Q: Does the tailgate leak in a following sea? A: This is not really an issue as that part of the boat is well out of the water when running, if you are backing down (Hard) in a following sea water will build up against the gasket and some water will get in the boat (no more than a boat with scuppers) this self drains immediately as the cockpit is completely self draining.
- Q: What color can I get? A: Any Color you like!




























































































































































Tom, It was great to catch up with you at the Annapolis Boat Show. I can't believe that's its been three years since our Eastport 32 "Volare" was delivered to us in Southern Maryland. After many years as sailors and a few more as powerboat owners, we had a wish list when we went looking for a new boat. We looked for three years for a larger boat to replace our 2001 Albin 28. We were on every cruising boat between 31 and 34 feet that showed up for the fall boat shows. What initially sold us on the Eastport 32 was the spacious design both above and below deck. My height of inches 6 feet 3 inches was not an issue because of the queen-size berth, the 6'7" pilot house, and good size head.

Also we loved the ability to select the colours, equipment, and other options to make our boat unique and suit our boating needs. We were also impressed with the quality of hull #1 and the way she handled during our sea trial.

Finally only drawing 22inches was a big plus because we have very little water depth at low tide and have to be able to get "Volare" on our lift.

Because of our busy schedules, we primarily use "Volare" as a day boat and weekender on the Potomac River where we live. She is a very comfortable boat for those many overnighters on the hook. But we also take her cruising on the Bay for a week to ten days. We have had her out in some very bad weather and she has always done well. When we are at a marina, we always receive many compliments on the boat's layout and overall design. Because the boat is kept on a lift and the bottom is not painted, and the sides are AWLGRIPed she is a breeze to maintain (disclaimer to follow). My teenage grandson is always in need of cash and has waxed the bottom for the past three years.
