Rig - Carbon Mast & Boom with swept spreaders, rod-rigging (checked & up-graded Sept 2016), kiwi foil head-stay with slugs, lazy-jacks on main, & 7/8ths backstays (primarily for sailing up-wind in a breeze, as no fixed back-stay)
Keel - Steel & Lead (T-keel)
Spinnaker Pole, & retractable prod, both carbon
Short Spinnaker Pole (for Rum Racing) Aluminium
Spade Rudder, needle roller bearings
