Description

Available for the first time in Australia waters, this Azimut 77S has low hours, exceptional condition and a huge option list with some fantastic recent additions. Behind her timeless sport exterior, Volare boasts 4 generous guest cabins with ensuite bathrooms and crews quarters for 3. Performance and fuel economy are outstanding with her Volvo IPS drives offering a smart 28 knot cruise and a top speed of 35 knots.

The main deck is all open plan with multi stage doors. The cockpit has a smart amenity station with an outdoor dining setting for 8, sunpads, electric sun awning and lots of locker storage. Inside, there is a spacious lounge setting and dining area with a huge overhead sunroof to bring the outdoor in. Down a short staircase forward there is a big galley with Miele appliances and lots of storage.

Some of the other popular areas of the 77s include the bow lounge which has an electric sunshade, the sportsfly which has an electric bimini and space for seats and lounges, and the fold down beach club and dual garage on the transom.
