Conditions

- The Owner must ensure that the Master has access to a copy of this document on board the vessel.
- The Owner and Master must ensure that the vessel is operated within LCS areas of coverage only.
- The Owner and Master must ensure that the vessel is operated as a Class 2C vessel, only within 5 nautical miles of the shore in restricted offshore operational areas or below.
- The Owner must ensure that the vessel is not operated if the forecast average wind speed exceeds 20 knots.
- The Owner and Master must ensure that the vessel returns to port if the prevailing average wind speed exceeds 20 knots.
- The Owner must ensure that the vessel is equipped with a coastal liferaft with a capacity equal to the total vessel complement.
- Note: This vessel is certified with the following NSCV service notations: C1 Accommodation Level (<12) hours, C4 Fire Risk Category (I), C6B Flooding Risk Category (II) & C3 Hull and Scantling Notation (Lloyds SSC-G2).
- Note: This vessel is due for its 10 year renewal survey in 2031 and every 10 years thereafter.
- Note: This vessel has been granted a specific exemption (SPEX-634), in relation to subdivision and flotation. The owner and master must ensure the conditions listed on the exemption are met and a copy of the exemption is kept with this certificate of survey.

This certificate is in force until 26 October 2026, unless suspended or revoked.
