I Nigel Robertson, as the owner's representative have attended on board the vessel many times over the years since 2017. Recently July 2023 to examine the vessels overall condition to establish its present seaworthy safety status and estimated current valuation.

1. HULL

The hull is a twin screw, timber built fore and aft plank on timber frames carvel monohull, with two decks, centre/aft superstructure, duckboard aft, raked stern and transom stern.

The Hull was found to be in satisfactory condition.

Engine room was found to be organised and clean with Bilges clean and free from oil.

The machinery and electrical were found to be well maintained and in a satisfactory condition with regular servicing undertaken buy outside tradesman and crew.

Main Engines Gardiner 6-cylinder diesel. Hours July 2023 around 4,500 each Oil samples done Cat Hastings Deering May 23. Samples found to have no issues.

8. ACCOMMODATION and VESSEL LAYOUT

Main Deck

- Main Salon
- Dining area 2x tables to sit 10
- 2x Guests cabins with shared en-suite bathroom
- Day head and shower
- Traditional aft deck sofa with dining table with access down to dive/swim platform.
- Access to engine room

Lower Decks

- Forward stairs from main deck down to 2 x double bunk guest cabins then on to master state room double bed and en-suite.
- Entrance from Aft main deck downstairs to crew accommodation with 3 bunks and en-suite also Dry storage area, built in 250 Lt freezer and laundry
- Mid-ship engine room arrangement

Upper Deck

- Traditional style stair way up from main deck up to wheelhouse and captain's cabin
- Large entertaining area aft with full walk access around wheelhouse with central stairs in front of wheelhouse for access down to bow and main deck.
- Partition aft space for tender and boat crane

9. CONDITION and SURVEY

The Vessel is classed as a "Pleasure Craft" is "an exempt ship" defined in the Merchant Shipping Act (Chapter 242) as: a vessel that is exclusively used for pleasure, Registration and Surveying is optional (Section 16(20& (3).

M/Y TIATA is kept to a survey standard with regards to Safety regulations and Seaworthiness.

The vessel only operates within Port Moresby harbor limits at any time.

Last out of water inspection of below water line was carried out in June 2020.

10. Valuation
