# S/Y Mad Fish

Mad Fish was built in 2009 at Advanced Composite Systems and is a Gary Lidgard designed Fusion 40 performance cruising catamaran. Mad Fish was professionally built as a safe and comfortable live aboard vessel capable of extended periods offshore and in remote locations.

The vessel was assembled by Fusion Catamarans and then fitted out with emphasis being place on an inventory of good quality equipment which could be easily accessed for maintenance, along with consideration of how best to reduce unnecessary maintenance by minimising equipment being fitted outside in the elements and the use of products requiring constant up keep. The internal finish has also been fully faired and painted to reduce the necessity of internal linings and allow for easy cleaning and maintenance.

During the build particular attention was paid to ensure the internal layout was open allowing plenty of light to penetrate. Extra port lights were fitted and all openings fitted with fly screens. The trifolding doors and sliding cockpit windows allow for good air flow through the boat. Almost everything has been hidden behind cupboard doors to try and make the internals of the boat feel more like a home rather than a mass of marine equipment dotted about.

The boat was built as a 2 cabin layout with galley down and a good sized bathroom with additional office/workshop space.

The Master cabin has a **king size** bed with inner spring mattress fitted on slats to allow air flow around the entire mattress preventing damp/mould accumulation. There are reading lights and fans fitted as well as an air conditioning outlet. The large walk in hanging locker at the fwd end of the cabin is backed up with 10 cupboards and 2 draws for storage. There is also a 240V outlet in the cabin.

The guest cabin is of similar layout with a queen size bed again with inner spring mattress and plenty of storage.

The bathroom is open with an independent shower cubicle, full size hand basin and electric toilet. A sewage treatment unit and holding tank has been fitted to enable the vessel to comply with regulations however this has not been used as of yet. An instant hot water system supplies hot water around the vessel and a 2.5kg front loader washing machine keeps the washing pile down.

The port mid hull houses mainly the electrical system with ac and dc switchboards. The ac power supply either coming from a 3000W Victron inverter/charger or a 3.5KVA 240v generator. The

primary 12 volt power supply comes from 4 x Renogy 160w solar panels, charging 460 A/h of lithium batteries.

Lithium house battery management is accessible from any android device anywhere on the vessel using the Victron Connect and also EV Power battery stats app. All battery management devices such as MPPT controllers have a Lithium profile which matches the requirements of the EV Power Lithium house bank. More batteries and/or solar panels can easily be added.

The compact 16,000BTU air conditioning unit is also housed in this area and supplies ducted air to the master cabin and saloon area via adjustable outlets. The port water and fuel tanks are situated in the hull in this area.

The starboard midships is the galley which is spacious and has quality household size equipment in the form of a Westinghouse 4 burner gas cooktop, Westinghouse gas oven as well as a microwave. There is plenty of cupboard space and bench tops while two port lights allow for plenty of light. The Spectra water maker Clarke pump and membrane is fitted under the twin stainless steel sinks. The starboard fuel and water tanks are situated in the hull.

The office/workshop has a large bench area with an additional stainless steel sink with a filtered drinking water outlet. There is plenty of storage space for spare parts and tools while also housing the fridge/freezer. An Icom HF radio and modem allow for good communications while outside of cell phone range. During construction 50Ft of copper sheet was laminated into the hull as well as a Guest Dynaplate being fitted for grounding. Under the bench top can be found access to the forward end of the generator to allow for ease of maintenance. There are numerous power outlets and bright lighting though out this space.

The main salon consists of a large U-shape couch with a mass of storage underneath it as well as the house battery bank. The table is fitted on a telescopic leg allowing the table to be lowed and a cushion inserted to make it a large day bed and a great area to sleep, close to the helm station, on those overnight passages. The coverings have all been made from quality Sunbrella fabric and are hard wearing and capable of being machine washed. The saloon floating floor is of laminated wood.

The tri-folding main doors open out into the cockpit. The cockpit windows slide vertically and do not need to be removed. Both the tri-folding doorway and cockpit windows are fitted with sliding fly screens. The seating is cushioned again with Sunbrella fabric and there is a shade that can be easily rigged and rolled up when not in use. The helm station has all the necessary instruments required including AIS and had a complete system upgrade in 2012. The chart plotter is positioned just inside the cockpit sliding window to protect it from the elements. Again the engine start panels are positioned just inside the doorway in a cupboard for the same reasons but are still easily within reach. A pilot hatch above the helm chair allows for another view point even though a clear view forward can be achieved through the saloon windows. The saloon windows and pilot hatch also have shade covers that can be fitted when not underway.

On the fore deck there are 4 large storage lockers. One used as the chain locker, one a gas locker and 2 for general purpose use. The two trampoline's have a shade cover that can easily be suspended above. The main coach house and deck also has a shade covers that are secured via bolt rope between the boom and lifelines.

Powering Mad Fish are two Yanmar 3YM30 diesel engines with two blade folding Gori props capable of 8.5Kn (fully loaded in cruising conditions). Economically motoring at 7kn on two engines or 5.5Kn on one engine. There are two main fuel tanks with a total capacity of 380L. A fuel cleaning/transfer system has been fitted for use in countries where the fuel quality can be unreliable. The vessel often carries a further 140litres of fuel in jerry cans housed in one of the general-purpose deck lockers.

The engines run 80A alternators which charge the start batteries via Balmar external regulators. The AGM start batteries also provide overflow charging to the Lithium house battery bank via Victron Orion DC to DC chargers.

The Allyacht Spars rig carries a comprehensive suite of sails. The fully battened One Sails mainsail has 3 reefing points, blind battens, Rutgerson batten boxes and comprehensive luff and leach lines and adjustments. There is a Sunbrella boom bag for the main with rugged construction and full length zip. The main is raised via an electric winch from the cockpit and tensioned at the mast. The Jib is a self tacking Doyle sail with a single sheet leading back to an electric winch in the cockpit. The powerful One Sails screecher is positioned on a 1.8m meter prodder pole as is the asymmetrical spinnaker. These sails are easily raised/lowered from the foredeck with the sheet leading aft.

Additionally Mad Fish has the luxury of a Spectra Cape Horn Extreme water maker which produces up to 50 litres an hour on 12v DC!. The two fresh water storage tanks having a total capacity of 400 litres and the washing machine requiring around 32 litres/cycle. There are also deck showers on both aft steps with the starboard one having both hot and cold water.
