The Farr 7500 has a proven track record as being one of the better designed trailer sailers. The Farr is a versatile yacht. You can tow it to a particular destination and then focus on enjoying the environment. If the weather isn't very good you don't have to launch. Your time isn't spent sailing in open waters getting from one place to another having to tolerate sailing in bad weather. Just drive to the location you wish to explore and raise the mast and off you go and enjoy yourself.

When you arrive at your destination you have a very powerful windlass run by a Marine Pro battery which can be controlled remotely from the cockpit, no-one has to go up to the bow to release the anchor. The anchor is one of the best a 6kg Rocna which can reset in its own length, no fears of having a dragging anchor during the night. You could pull up the keel and back up onto the beach or wait for the tide to go out and place the spacers under the stern.

Nalani has loads of space inside and in cockpit. Removable entry panels to make for more spacious access to cabin. The pop top gives you full 190cm headroom. Redco roller trailer for easy drive-off and drive-on retrieval for husband/wife team and family fun. Nalani comes with foldable table for the cockpit so you can dine comfortably on deck under the sun shade which reaches from the mast to the bimini.

There are two fishing rod holders at the stern where you can put two rods to go fishing for your next meal. The yacht has a Raymarine Element plotter and fishfinder which has Australian and New Zealand lighthouse charts and chirp sonar with hypervision to look for fish.

You have a 3.2m inflatable with an aluminium bottom and a 12volt electric pump. A pulley system is attached to the bimini frame to lower the outboard down to the inflatable. Attach the engine to the inflatable and off you go fishing or exploring. The pulley system can also be used to raise a bucket of water to wash the engine after use.

Nalani has had extensive improvements made to its electrical system so you can live off the grid, just plug a generator into the shore power socket and you have as much versatility as you would in an off road caravan. You have refrigeration supplied by a dual zone refrigerator that can run off 240volts, 12volts or its own 100watt dedicated solar panel. It has a controller that chooses automatically which power source to use. The battery system has two methods of charging the batteries, via the solar panel or by using a generator or shore power with the ProMariner Prosport HD 12V 20A 3 Bank charger to charge all of the batteries at once.

In the evenings you can watch Television. Just set up the double bed in the cockpit and connect your phone, USB or DVD and enjoy a relaxing show with a glass of wine if you so desire. The RV router and an RV WIFI High Gain Antenna gives you an extended range to receive signals from land. With a Telstra sim card you will have access to all your favourite channels and services in quite remote areas.

Nalani has been fitted out with an electrical system that enables you to live off the grid, enjoying the freedom and peace of mind that you will find in some of Australia's beautiful remote waterways.

ELECTRICS

12 Volt Blue Sea 12volt power board with magnetic breaker switches to manage all 12 volt circuitry which includes, cabin lights, 4 x USB C sockets, 2 x Lighter sockets, VHF and 27 meg Radios, Navigation lights including Stern Light and anchor light. An 85 Watt Solar panel with solar controller with 2 x 120 AH house batteries and a 12 Volt Marine Pro windlass battery. The solar panel feeds the two house batteries which are connected to the windlass battery with a Victron DC to DC charger and a Victron battery protector with Bluetooth phone app software management.

240 Volt Blue Sea power board with magnetic breaker switches for 240 volt power supply with regulation Safety Switch all fitted by qualified electrician. Also a ProMariner ProSportHD 20 Plus on-board battery charger with three line battery charging which connects to all three batteries and runs off 240 volts proved by shore power, caravan park power or a generator. The has 2 x two socket power points with 2 x USB C sockets in the main cabin and a two socket power point with 2 x USB C sockets behind the stove in the galley.

ELECTRONICS Raymarine VHF and 27 meg radios with an RV WI-FI+ router with a long distance 4G aerial. This enables connection to 4G network from offshore and the router can be accessed by anyone on the yacht. All you need is a Telstra Sim Card.

NAVIGATION Raymarine Element 7 HV, 7" MFD with HV-100 All-In-One Transom Mount Transducer with 1.2 megahertz sonar technology, turns up the resolution of DownVision, SideVision, and RealVision 3D to a new level of precision imaging and fish identification, letting you see structures, vegetation, and fish with amazing life-like clarity.

STEERING Raymarine ST2000+ Tiller Pilot and manual tiller.

SAILS Battened Main plus spare mainsail with jack stays, Genoa. There is a roll up main. The main rolls around the boom as you drop it with a sail cover that zips over it so I could leave it in position. You can remove the whole bundle and store it inside.

RIGGING The back stay was replaced other stays are in good order. Roos and Co rigging tensioner for setting the tension after raising the mast.

ENTERTAINMENT 1924B1 Axis Television Set (DVD/TV) which runs on 12volt with Chromecast dongle. Two XP8 water proof portable wireless bluetooth speakers with connectivity to your phone or other devices using Bluetooth, MicroSD or Auxilliary input.

REFRIGERATION Brass Monkey 55 litre dual zone refrigerator with a 15amp/hrs Lithium battery with its built in controller which can be charged with 240 Volts, 12 Volts or a 100watt solar panel specifically for the refrigerator. Has a Bluetooth app to manage temperatures.

GALLEY Methylated Spirit 2 burner stove with 4 litre bottle of 95% high grade alcohol.

Fresh water at Sink. 700 Watt Microwave when connect to shore power or generator. You could also use an induction hot plate if connected to 240volt supply if you were so inclined. Water bladders have recently been replaced. Electric and manual faucets.

OTHER Swing Rudder, Boarding ladder, Bimini with sunshade from mast to bimini. Extendable cabin top, two stern cleats convertible to rod holders.

TRAILER Dual axle Redco boat trailer ATM Over 1.02T Boat Trailer with hydraulic brakes and AL-KO brake actuator connected to the car brake controller. Hydraulic Brakes have new callipers all round and new brake rotors. Electric boat winch with remote (Can be used to raise mast) and a Manual boat Winch. ADDITIONAL EQUIPMENT 1. A small portable air-conditioner which hasn't been fitted. 2. Also a jibe preventer which has to be fitted to the boom to stop crew being hit by a jibing boom. 3. There are two spacers to be placed under the stern when in shallow water or when the tide goes out. 4. Mast raiser and Mast Mate for raising the mast. 5. Salt Away outboard flushing system with 3.8 litres of Salt Away active solution as well as a bucket with a pulley to wash inflatable outboard. 6. Assortment of navigation maps extending from Gold Coast to Whitsunday Passage at various scales and a Beacon to Beacon Guide Charts from Yeppoon to Currumbin. 7. Number of Sailing Technique videos. 8. Whisker Pole and Spinnaker Pole. 9. Handydock Boathook Docking aid. 10. 12 Volt Spotlight that runs off boat batteries. 11. Small Vacuum Cleaner. 12. C.A.O.S Battery powered Shower. 13. Two Jack Stays. 14. Six Fenders. 15. Wheel lock that prevents someone removing the wheel. 16. Gin Pole with pulley system and eye bolts to be fitted. 17.
