Sceptre 41 - Capable Bluewater Cruiser

The Sceptre 41 "Kiana" is a well-built Canadian yacht, crafted for both offshore adventures and comfortable living. Starting with the spacious cockpit, it is designed for ease of operation, featuring an uncluttered layout with dual helms and navigation instruments thoughtfully arranged for accessibility. The traveler is positioned forward of the spray dodger, keeping the cockpit clear and functional. Step through the transom door onto the swimstep, and you'll find your way into a light-filled saloon. Large windows provide an airy, open feel while offering excellent views of your surroundings. The layout includes a functional galley to port, complete with a fridge/freezer, making it practical for extended stays onboard. The saloon also features a dining table with seating for six or more, creating an inviting space for meals or socializing. The accommodation includes two double cabins: an aft cabin to starboard and a forward cabin with a generous V-berth. A separate head and shower are positioned forward, offering convenience and privacy. The navigation station and a second helm with a captain's seat provide additional control and versatility, whether underway or at anchor. "Kiana" is powered by a 55hp Yanmar engine and comes with a well-rounded sail inventory, including a main sail with a third reef, a furling Genoa, staysail, Code D Gennaker, and a Spinnaker with sock. Proven in global sailing, this vessel is well-equipped for serious cruising and live-aboard comfort, ready to take on new adventures.
