The traveler is positioned forward of the spray dodger, keeping the cockpit clear and functional. Step through the transom door onto the swimstep, and you'll find your way into a light-filled saloon. Large windows provide an airy, open feel while offering excellent views of your surroundings. The layout includes a functional galley to port, complete with a fridge/freezer, making it practical for extended stays onboard. The saloon also features a dining table with seating for six or more, creating an inviting space for meals or socializing. The accommodation includes two double cabins: an aft cabin to starboard and a forward cabin with a generous V-berth. A separate head and shower are positioned forward, offering convenience and privacy. The navigation station and a second helm with a captain's seat provide additional control and versatility, whether underway or at anchor. "Kiana" is powered by a 55hp Yanmar engine and comes with a well-rounded sail inventory, including a main sail with a third reef, a furling Genoa, staysail, Code D Gennaker, and a Spinnaker with sock.
