This world cruiser has full keel and is built of solid fiberglass. The boat has main sail with 2 reefs, double furling headsails and two whisker poles. The boat can be sailed downwind with the headsails opened on both sides, which gives easy control from cockpit.

The boat features double berth cabin in bow, head and closet in front of the mast. A linear galley is on starboard side and U- shaped sofa and table on port side. The sofa table can be lowered to additional small double berth. The nav table is next to the galley and there is quarter berths on both sides on aft.

Standing stainless rigging is new from 2021, both head stays, and all side stays. The back stays are made with dyneema 2024/2025. New 200Ah lithium house bank 08/2024, new Victron DC to DC charger from engine to the house bank and new starter battery 2025 (Not yet used). 320W solar panel and mppt controller are installed 2021 and the boat is self sufficient on electricity in the tropics on our use. Volvo Penta marine gear box has new conic clutch and shifter changed in 2022.
