The Bali 4.2 is a 42-foot (12.85m) luxury sailing catamaran known for its innovative "open" concept, blending indoor and outdoor spaces with a solid forward cockpit and a tilting "garage" door giving unparalleled space and comfort in salon for a yacht of this size. Easy access to foredeck through door from salon to foredeck makes it easy to enjoy the evening breeze when at anchor.

Designed for comfort and easy sail handling, it features a massive owners' cabin and 2 guest cabins with en-suite bathrooms. Enjoy a large flybridge helm for spectacular views and easy sailing, and is ideal for ocean cruising or day trips. Integrated starlink, solar panels, watermaker and extended fuel tanks allow for long distance off-grid cruising. Unique opportunity for catamaran in excellent condition and option to be income producing as well. Commercial survey re-issued in June 2025.

The Bali 4.2 remains a current model available from Bali Catamarans in France. Purchase for a fraction of the price of a new boat from factory. Meticulously maintained - Full servicing records available. Can sleep up to 8 persons.

Currently in charter with Dream Yacht Charters (Airlie Beach QLD) but kept in pristine condition by regular owner visits and well tested in over 5,000 NM sailed by owners in Australia from Newcastle to Airlie beach and beyond. Proven to sail well in heavy offshore conditions and light winds equally well. Over \$ 200,000 in future bookings for next 6 months provides a unique opportunity to own a boat, use it for up to 6 weeks each year, and make a profit. Alternatively, it is available to use as your own private yacht. New survey issued in June 2025.

Construction

- Hull built in one piece for greater stiffness
- Anti-leeway plan provided by 2 profiled keels limiting drag
- Hull made in GRP-infused PVC foam sandwich, polyester resin
- Anti-osmotic vinylester underwater hull protection
- Deck in GRP-infused foam sandwich with monolithic/plywood reinforcements
- Main bulkheads GRP sandwich and secondary bulkheads in multilayer plywood, laminated or glued

Interior

- Owners Version with full owners' cabin on port side and two guest cabins on starboard side
- Custom designed mattress topper for owners' cabin (memory foam) bed provided to improve comfort.
- LCD 12 v colour TV in owners' cabin
- 3kg/ 1,5kg washer-dryer machine 220V in owners' cabin
- Owners' cabin with full bathroom, separate toilet, double sink, and shower cubicle.
- Guest cabins have separate toilets/sink and "jack & jill" shared shower cubicle

- Reverse cycle 220 V air conditioning in hulls for 3 cabins
- Can sleep 8 persons - 3 cabins plus salon table converts into double bed with shorter legs and separate cushion included
- Each cabin has USB ports for charging next to bed and 230 V outlet
- Reading lights on bedhead and integrated LED lighting.
- 1 fan per cabin (larger in owners' cabin) plus overhead hatches and side port windows for ventilation

- 2 x Yanmar 45 HP engines. – Engine hours – (2569/2568 hours) as at 13th March 2026, regularly serviced by certified Yanmar engineers with service records.
- Engine room & locker hatches on gas struts
- Rocna Galvanised 33 Kg anchor and 70m galvanised chain – Original Delta 25 Kg Anchor supplied by Bali retained as spare with 50M rope rode in foredeck locker
- Electric windlass with corded remote and chain counter/remote control at helm station (Muir Storm VR2200 12v 10mm installed July 2025)

- Rainman Portable Water maker and complete set of replacement filters only been used 10 hours. 120 Litres per hour AC powered.

- Comfortable swim ladder with large handles and teak steps
- 2 layers of antifouling with Epoxy base coat. (Applied May 2025, will be completed again May 2026)
- 2 x forepeak cabins for storage with large flush hatch access – additionally one has access from forward guest cabin
- High quality mooring lines and fenders
- Additional cleat mounted on bow cross beam for attaching mooring lines
- Underwater lights at transom
- Stern spring cleats
- Permanent transom protection – starboard bumper at back of sugar scoops
