

Back Cove 340



Back Cove's first outboard model is making waves in the boating community. Capable of a 30 knot cruise speed with the convenience and durability of four stroke outboards, she can extend your cruising grounds and make every outing more exciting. The Back Cove 340's all-new hull design features Back Cove's proprietary Trailing Edge Lift Surface (TRELIS®) which gets her on plane faster using less horsepower than other outboard designs.



Her helm deck is spacious, airy and bright. Surrounded by large opening windows, this space is out of the weather and truly comfortable. To port, the seat back can face forward to create a comfortable mate's seat or it can face aft toward the elegantly finished helm deck table. A second seat also converts handily from cockpit facing to face the helm deck table. To starboard and aft of the ergonomically designed helm is the fully equipped on-deck galley with convection microwave, two burner electric cooktop and ample storage for the gourmet chefs wares. Two drawer style refrigerators are found below the mate and helm seats.

The Back Cove 340's cockpit is a comfortable, spacious and inviting area for you and your guests to relax. The swim platform extends to both sides of the engines to make boarding safe and secure, and a convenient transom door opens at deck level for egress to and from the cockpit.



Below deck, the 340 offers a rare feature in the world of outboard powered boats: a comfortable queen-sized island berth with ample storage below. There is also storage throughout this master stateroom, with drawers and lockers all finely crafted in varnished American cherry. Aft of the berth is a split head unit offering the WC to one side and a separate shower to the other.



The introduction of this first Back Cove outboard has opened new horizons of performance and freedom of design. Spaces below the helm deck are freed up for boating accessories such as folding bikes, inflatable paddle boards and kayaks. There is storage enough for everything you may want to bring on board for a day at the beach or a week's cruise to your favorite destination (or maybe even one you haven't dreamed of until now).
